Public Law

Katarina's practice involves challenging and defending public law decisions in a wide variety of areas including mental health and incapacity, healthcare and social welfare, professional regulation, education and financial services.

In the field of **healthcare**, Katarina appeared in the Supreme Court as junior counsel on behalf of the intervener in the assisted suicide appeals of *R (Nicklinson & Lamb) v Ministry of Justice and R (AM) v Director of Public Prosecutions* [2014] UKSC 38.

Katarina has acted in judicial review proceedings relating to the provision of accommodation and support to adults and children under the Care Act 2014 and Children Act 1989. She regularly advises on **community care** issues in the Court of Protection. Katarina acts for a range of professionals in proceedings before **regulatory bodies**, including the Nursing and Midwifery Council and the National College for Teaching and Leadership. She recently succeeded in a statutory appeal against a decision by the NMC that a nurse's fitness to practise was impaired (*Warren v NMC* [2017] EWHC 793 (Admin)). Katarina also has experience of **public international law**. She represented the DPP (led by Paul Rogers) before the Administrative Court and the Court of Appeal in proceedings which considered whether a member of a special mission visiting the UK was immune from arrest and criminal prosecution for alleged offences of torture committed in Egypt (*R (ota Freedom and Justice Party) v (1) Secretary of State for Foreign and Commonwealth Affairs (2) The Director of Public Prosecutions* [2016] EWHC 2010 (Admin); [2018] EWCA Civ 1719).

Katarina has experience of **immigration law** and has acted on behalf of the government in applications for permission for judicial review in the Upper Tribunal.

Between 2014 and 2015 Katarina was seconded to the Financial Conduct Authority for eight months, where she specialised in EU and public law in the context of **financial services**.

Education

Clinical Negligence

Katarina accepts instructions from claimants and defendants.
